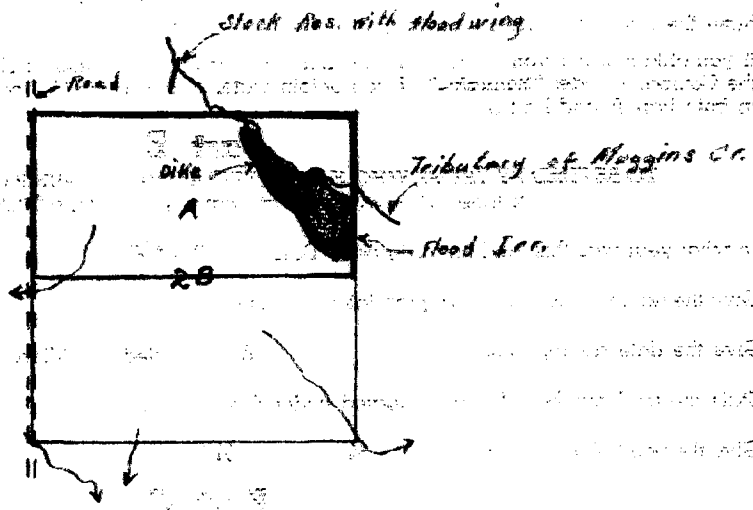

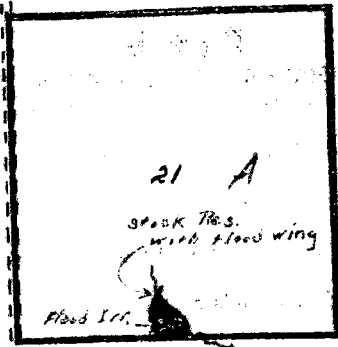


IRRIGATED LAND
