

Dear Mr. Orcutt:

In accordance with the 1939 Session Law (Section 149.68 Montana Session Law) requiring the State Engineer to investigate and prepare a complete record of all water rights in Montana, the State Engineer has been conducting a water resources survey in Custer County.

We are unable to find a recorded water filing for the land that you irrigate in the N¹/₂ Sec. 2, T. 3N., R. 4E. If a filing was made for this land we would like to have you send us the name of the appropriator, the date filed on, and the number of inches filed on. If no recorded filing was made we would like to have you send us the name of the first user and the date, or the approximate date, that the land was first irrigated so that we may establish a date of priority for this land.

We would like to have you make this a first on your agenda and send this information to us as soon as possible in the enclosed, stamped, self-addressed envelope.
