EXTRACT FROM HOUSE BILL, NO. 29.

Section 1. Hereafter a cubic foot of water (7.48 gallons) per second of time shall be the legal standard for the measurement of water in this State.

Section 2. Where water rights expressed in miners' inches have been granted, one hundred miners' inches shall be considered equivalent to a flow of two and one-half cubic feet (18.7 gallons) per second; two hundred miners' inches shall be considered equivalent to a flow of five cubic feet (37.4 gallons) per second, and this proportion shall be observed in determining the equivalent flow represented by any number of miners' inches. [Approved March 3, 1899.]

This is in response to the enclosed copy of the GW-3 form, Notice of Completion of Groundwater Appropriation Without Well, that was filed in the Toole County Courthouse at Shelby, Montana on November 20, 1972 at 4:35 p.m., document number 264705.

Unfortunately, the GW-3 form which you have filed is intended for the purpose of appropriating groundwater taken by developed springs, drains, and sub-irrigation. (This does not include "surface water run-off" from coulees.) "Surface run-off" from a coulee would be classified within the jurisdiction of surface water laws, and not groundwater laws.

Enclosed is a "sample" form entitled Notice of Appropriation to be used for appropriating surface water, and a pamphlet on Surface Water Rights. Please note the areas underlined in red. (The Notice of Appropriation form should be recorded and filed in the local county clerk and recorders office in which the water is being diverted and used. Additional copies of the form can be purchased at most major office supply stores in Montana.)

Also enclosed is a two page report on six sections of Montana's surface water laws, dealing specifically with appropriating unadjudicated surface waters for your own information. (There are different procedures to follow in appropriating surface water from adjudicated or court decreed streams.)
